► Assessment

The Alliance Française Bordeaux Aquitaine suggests that the students evaluate their own level of competence in writing and oral (oral and written comprehension, oral and written expression) in relation to the levels of competence from the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) A1/A2/B1/B2/C1/C2.

This assessment only concerns students who have followed the course for at least one month. It is organized by the teachers and takes place on the 4th week of the session of each session. A certificate is delivered according to the level the student has attained. The students who have not completed a full month will receive a certificate of attendance justifying the number of hours they have followed.
