YOUR OBJECTIVE

This workshop is for students who want to improve their pronunciation so that French people can understand them better and they can communicate more effectively in everyday situations. This workshop is for you if you want to improve your pronunciation and speak more fluently.

METHODOLOGY

The exercises we offer work on both the voice and the body, as the two are inseparable when it comes to ensuring good pronunciation: gestures, breathing, positioning of the tongue and lips, etc.

We place great importance on playfulness, to help students overcome their inhibitions and ensure that pronunciation becomes a pleasure.

CONTENT

The sessions are independent of each other and each address a specific phonetic difficulty.
